##### Registration:

This is done with the priest by either meeting with him after Sunday Mass or by appointment.

##### Participation:

As a member of the Church, you are accepting the responsibility of weekly worship as well as supporting God's work here through giving of yourself, your time and talents, and a worthy Sunday offering to show your love for God and your gratitude for His many favors.

#### RECONCILIATION/CONFESIONE:

One-half hour prior to weekend Mass or by request/appointment.

#### BAPTISM/BATTESIMO:

Preparation is required for the reception of the sacrament. Parents are encouraged to call the Rectory and set up an appointment before the birth of their child.

#### MATRIMONY/MATRIMONIO:

Arrangements should be made at least six or more months in advance. A marriage preparation program is required.

**November:** Remember the Saints and our deceased family members and friends throughout the month of November. There was an "All Souls" envelope in your monthly packet to list your loved ones. *These envelopes will be placed on the altar for the month of November and will be prayed for at all Masses.*

**Saint Frances Xavier Cabrini (Mother Cabrini):** Saint Frances Xavier Cabrini was born in Lombardy, Italy, in 1850. In Codogno, Italy, in the diocese of Lodi, she founded the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart in 1880. In 1887, she established many schools, hospitals, and orphanages. With the encouragement of Pope Leo XIII, she set out for the United States in 1889, where, for the next twenty-eight years, she continued to establish schools, hospitals, and orphanages. Her missionary zeal also led her to South America, where she founded schools in Argentina, Brazil, and Nicaragua. Mother Cabrini died in Chicago on December 22, 1917, and on July 7, 1946, she, an immigrant from Italy, became the first United States citizen to be canonized. Her missionary sisters of the Sacred Heart continue the many works she began to make the love of Christ visible in care for the multiple needs of immigrants, the sick, the poor, and the uneducated. *Through the generosity of Dorothy Ambrosia Murnane, a stained glass window depicting Mother Cabrini, Padre Pio and La Madonna dello Splendore was installed in the vestibule of SJB. November 13th is the feast day of Mother Cabrini and we will celebrate Mass in her honor at 7:00 p.m.*
