### **PARISH MEMBERSHIP:**

We welcome you into our Parish Families. Membership in the parish consists of two parts:

#### **Registration:**

This is done with the priest by either meeting with him after Sunday Mass or by appointment.

#### **Participation:**

As a member of the Church, you are accepting the responsibility of weekly worship as well as supporting God's work here through giving of yourself, your time and talents, and a worthy Sunday offering to show your love for God and your gratitude for His many favors.

### **RECONCILIATION/CONFESSIONE:**

One-half hour prior to weekend Mass or by request/appointment.

### **BAPTISM/BATTESIMO:**

Preparation is required for the reception of the sacrament. Parents are encouraged to call the Rectory and set up an appointment before the birth of their child.

### **MATRIMONY/MATRIMONIO:**

Arrangements should be made at least six or more months in advance. A marriage preparation program is required.

### **SACRAMENT OF THE SICK/INFIRMI:**

**In cases of emergencies, please call anytime. Please notify the Parish Office for Communion calls to the sick, shut-ins.** Due to privacy laws, if parishioners wish to be visited in the hospital, they should contact the Parish Office directly and give the information regarding the hospitalization.

**If you are scheduled for surgeries or other medical procedures,** please contact the Parish Office in advance so that Fr. Metzger can administer Anointing of the Sick prior to the procedure.
