RECONCILIATION/CONFESSIONE:

One half-hour prior to weekend Mass or by request/appointment.

BAPTISM/BATTESIMO:

Preparation is required for the reception of the sacrament.

Parents are encouraged to call the Rectory and set up an appointment before the birth of their child.

MATRIMONY/MATRIMONIO:

Arrangements should be made at least six or more months in advance. A marriage preparation program is required.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK/INFERMI:

In cases of emergencies, please call anytime. Please notify the
Parish Office for Communion calls to the sick, shut-ins.

From the Deacon's Desk

Dear friends in Christ,

Have you ever felt that you had a frontrow seat for an event you did not want to see in the first place? That you were watching a "human train wreck" about to happen? That's the way you may feel when you hear the **Gospel** this weekend. Once the **Pharisee** in the story says in his

so called prayer, "O God, I thank you that I am not like the rest of humanity," you know this is a train-wreck-in-the-making. Is this Pharisee offering an open-ended prayer – or an airtight audit he can proudly take to the bank?

The **Gospel** shows us that true prayer is always directed to **God**. True prayer comes out of our awareness of our total reliance on **God**. If virtue goes skin-deep and our relationship with everyone else is to look down on them, then pride is at work. **Pride** focuses our attention on ourselves and closes us to a proper relationship with **God**. **Pride** is about us exalting ourselves when we truly want to be exalted by **God**. To be exalted by **God** is to have humility to recognize that **God** is all in all.

We come to the **Eucharist** this weekend not to pat ourselves on the back or make sure that **God's** records are up to date. No, we come because the **Eucharist** teaches us to pray more honestly and humbly.

Saint John the Baptist, pray for us!


