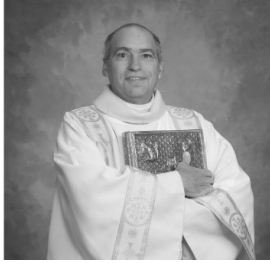

### From the Deacon's Desk

Dear friends in Christ,

We come with our families and friends with the faith that, by partaking of His **Body and Blood**, we will be strengthened to be His living **Body** in this needy world of ours.
