#### RECONCILIATION/CONFESSIONE:

One half-hour prior to weekend Mass or by request/appointment.

#### **BAPTISM/BATTESIMO:**

Preparation is required for the reception of the sacrament.

Parents are encouraged to call the Rectory and set up an appointment before the birth of their child.

#### **MATRIMONY/MATRIMONIO:**

Arrangements should be made at least six or more months in advance. A marriage preparation program is required.

#### SACRAMENT OF THE SICK/INFERMI:

In cases of emergencies, please call anytime. Please notify the
Parish Office for Communion calls to the sick, shut-ins.

Due to privacy laws, if parishioners wish to be visited in the hospital, they should contact the Parish Office directly and give the information regarding the hospitalization.

If you are scheduled for surgeries or other medical procedures, please contact the Parish Office in advance so that a priest can administer Anointing of the Sick prior to the procedure.



#### From the Deacon's Desk

Dear friends in Christ,

One of my favorite television programs when I was growing up was a quiz show called *To Tell the Truth*. On this show, three contestants, all claiming to be the same person, were quizzed by panelists about their identity. The **two** phonies could lie to the panelists, but the real

person had to tell the truth. The best part of the program was when the host, **Bud Collyer**, would boom out, "**Will the real Mr./Mrs. So-and-So please stand up?**" And then we'd find out who the actual inventor... or skydiver ...or race car driver was.

I was surprised to see that some people were better at being somebody else than they were at being their own real selves. Perhaps it shouldn't have come as such a surprise. It seems easier for us to put up a false front than to be authentically who we are. And yet when we discover who we are at our deepest core, and are able to be that person fully, we are liberated, and **God** is well pleased.

Jesus had His revelatory moment of identity when His Heavenly Father boomed out, "Will the real beloved son of God please stand up?" Then Jesus arose from the waters of the Jordan knowing, deep down, His identity and His mission. You all know the real words: "This is my beloved Son, of whom I am well pleased, listen to Him!"

We each need help to discover and assume our true identity. Our home and our parish here at **Saint John the Baptist**, can be a great place to get that guidance. At home, at church, and with your friends, are you putting forth the invitation, "Will the real you ... baptized, anointed and sanctified on the day of your own baptism to be the hands, feet, voice and very self of Christ in this world today... please stand up?"


