## **MATRIMONY/MATRIMONIO:**

# **AROUND US**

<u>Liturgical Calendar</u>: The month of **January** is dedicated to the **Holy Name of Jesus**. The first twelve days of **January** fall during the liturgical season known as **Christmas** which is represented by the liturgical color white. The remaining days of **January** are the beginning of **Ordinary Time**.

Epiphany of the Lord: Today the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Epiphany. "The Lord and ruler are coming; kingship is His, and government and power." With these words, the Church proclaims that today's feast brings to a perfect fulfillment all the purposes of Advent. Epiphany, therefore, marks the liturgical zenith of the Advent Christmas Season. Three mysteries are encompassed in this solemnity: the adoration of the Christ Child by the Magi, the Baptism of Christ and the wedding feast at Cana.

Respect Life Mass: Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children: The annual Respect Life Mass will be Wednesday, January 22, 2020, 10:30 a.m. at St. Joseph Cathedral. On this day of the anniversary of the U.S. Supreme Court decision Roe v. Wade, our diocese will join all dioceses of the United States in observing a Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children. All are invited.
